Roles of Involved Institutions

International Accredited Hospitals

- This Hospital will be the lead organization for the programme in India and responsible for the recruitment, the first 2 years of training and employment.
- The hospital will liaise with USW and BTA in UK and look after visiting UK trainers including their travel, lodging and boarding.

University of South Wales

- This University will be UK ORGANISATION participating in delivering MBA training as part of this programme.

BAPIO Training Academy (BTA)

- BTA will be coordinating this programme in UK and link between India and UK.
- It will coordinate with the faculty visits to India and organise UK induction and mentoring.
- It will provide pastoral care to ensure the wellbeing of Indian doctors whilst in the UK.

Program Quality Assurance

- 360-degree feedback and real time intervention will be undertaken to safeguard the standard of the programme.
- The programme in India and the UK will be closely monitored and audited by experts deputed by the BAPIO Training Academy.

Responsibilities of the UK Trusts
